What does PaNaMa stand for?

The abbreviation stands for **P**apa (daddy), **N**achwuchs (offspring), **M**ama (mummy). PaNaMa is a family centre for families with children between the ages of 0 and 6 years.

Where exactly is PaNaMa located?

We are to be found in the parish hall and the open space surrounding the Auferstehungskirche, Bremervörde (Neues Feld 60) and in the parish hall of the Pauluskirchengemeinde, Gnarrenburg (Hindenburgstr. 60a)

What's on at PaNaMa?

We organise open groups, which are directed at the developmental level of the children (lying, crawling, toddling etc.). While the children are playing, the parents have time to take a breath, to have a cup of coffee and to share their experiences.

All groups are taking place on a weekly basis and can be visited free of charge and without prior registration. In addition, the family centre offers courses and projects covering different subjects.
